



AR151 Business Association Scholarship Program

A scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to enroll 12 hours or more in an accredited college or university. There will be a minimum of a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to your senior graduate. Selection is based on essays, grade point average, letters of recommendation, school and/or community activities (9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades only). Scholarships will be paid to the college — in the student's name.

Criteria:

- Graduating Seniors from Taft, Warren, Brennan, Harlan & Stevens High School, in San Antonio Texas are eligible.
- Full-time enrollment (12 hours or more) in an accredited college or university.
- Copy of application for admissions to school of choice.
- Incoming college freshman who maintained a B average throughout high school —verified by high school transcript (may be unofficial).
- Completed scholarship application.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals with direct knowledge of students abilities and potential.

All questions to be answered on a separate paper:

- As a student in High School, describe one particular event or experience that has made an impact on you that has made you a better person. (300 word minimum)
- What one event or person has influenced you the most during your four years of high school. How will this influence the decisions you make as you leave high school and head off to college? (300 word minimum)
- If you were given \$10,000 to better your community, what would you do and why? (1 page essay minimum)
- List your high school involvement in the following areas (grades 9—12): community activities, clubs, athletics, student government, and other organizations. Be specific about the length of time you were involved and what role you played. Please give the complete name of the organization rather than acronyms.
- List any honors or awards you received during high school (grades 9—12).
